


# IN ASHEVILLE & BUNCOMBE COUNTY RUNDEP


in state & local tax revenues are generated by the visitor economy.

#### Forecasts for FY25




- The pace of recovery will depend on the timing of repairs to infrastructure including power and water systems, highways, and natural assets including the Blue Ridge Parkway.
- Additionally, there is a marketing and communication need to convey to potential guests that Asheville is open, accessible, and still an appealing place to visit.
- Quick action on these factors could accelerate economic recovery, including lodging tax revenue.

Based on lodging tax revenue in Buncombe County, FY19-FY25




- Revised forecast is approximately \$11.5M less than original FY25 net revenue budget.
- Lodging tax collections are forecast to decline 33% for FY25, to the lowest level since the pandemic in FY20.
- Year-over-year monthly declines in the immediate aftermath of Hurricane Helene are expected to gradually lessen over the course of the fiscal year.








# Economic Impact of National Parks

# **I-40 Update**

#### **Temporary Emergency Repairs**

- -Contract Cost: \$14 million total
- -Soil nail wall stabilization and base stabilization of remnants of the East Bound Lanes to protect the remaining roadway.
- -One Lane each direction with reduced speed limit of 40 mph.
- -Anticipated completion **March 1** (dependent on weather)

#### **Permanent Emergency Repairs**

- -CMGC- Contractor Manager, General Contract
- -Cost Estimate \$750 Million Dollars + Largest disaster project in process in the United States
- -Date of Availability February 24, 2025
- -Completion Date = 2027-2028
- -Millions of cubic yards of material to source and many retaining walls.



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



# Current Road Status






- 312 miles open
  - All of Virginia
- 157 miles closed
  - Some will open after slide repairs and debris removal

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
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# **Helene Impacts**

- In the aftermath of Helene, coordination efforts were impacted due to the needed focus of the local staff of both the Department and the COA on the recovery effort.
- While the recovery effort was and continues to be our immediate priority the long-term transportation needs that I-26 addresses are still critical to Asheville and WNC.
- Central Department Staff continued to work with the DB team to complete the O&R process on schedule.
- This was only possible due to the significant coordination effort and communication with local stakeholders



#### **Result of I-26 O&R Process**

- Scope reductions, material changes, risk mitigations resulted in a successful completion of the O&R process
- Overall Savings to the Project are approximately \$125 Million dollars
  - \$63 Million in Bridge Reductions
  - \$26 Million in Miscellaneous Structures
  - \$24 Million in Paving
  - \$7 Million in Earthwork
- With these savings the Department is moving forward with the project on its original schedule with completion expected in 2031.





# **Next Steps**

- Additional Outreach
  - Updates to the project website reflecting the changes to the scope.
  - Public Project Update Meeting to be scheduled in the coming months.
- With the O&R Process complete and an agreement with the DB Team in place, design work on the project will commence
- Continued coordination with local stakeholders including the COA as we work toward final design
- The Department is continuing to evaluate the construction phasing and work zone traffic control for additional time and cost savings
- Estimated Project Schedule
  - ROW Acquisition Fall of 2025
  - Utility Relocation Spring of 2026
  - Construction Fall of 2026



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
